

Recreated Historical Portrait

Using an iconic and recognizable piece of art or design that contains a person, your challenge is to recreate it in photograph form.

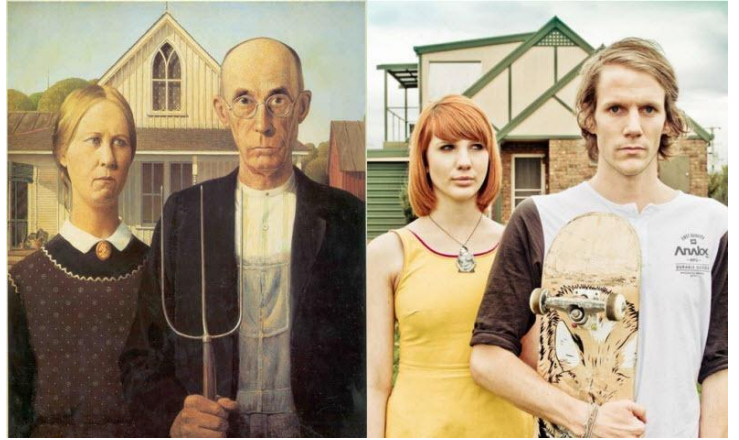
You will need to think about how to capture the setting, clothing/costume, props, light source, lighting intensity, camera angle (view point), range of colour or values and especially composition of space and pose of your subject as well as who your model will be. Each of these items need to be explained by you and included in a written proposal. They should be the headings you use in your proposal document. Include the image you are using and a paragraph about the important noteworthy things about it that you research. This must be submitted in advance submitted for review & discussion.

You can make this a self-portrait and use the camera timer and a tripod *or* you can photograph a friend, staff member or family member (also using a tripod)



You can recreate your portrait to be classic and true to the original image or you can apply a modern context.

You need to do all of the prep work and have it planned out so when your model arrives you can instruct them very clearly. You should not need to ask them for guidance, you should be the one directing them. To do this you must have developed a clear vision and a very well thought out plan well in advance!
