
RENAISSANCE means "REBIRTH"

The word "Renaissance" derived from the term "la rinascita", which means rebirth

Renaissance art is the painting, sculpture and decorative arts of that period of European history known as the Renaissance, emerging as a distinct style in Italy in about 1400 and lasting until the 1600s. It took place in parallel with developments which occurred in philosophy, literature, music and science.

Sculpture and painting were characterized by

- individualism
- naturalism

"naturalism" describes a true-to-life style which involves the representation or depiction of nature (including people) with the least possible distortion or interpretation.

- proportion
- classicism (Greek & Roman revival)
- · perspective is invented
- First secular artworks since classical times
- Christianity remained a dominant force in the lives (and art) of princes and paupers alike

Bronze

Stone: Sandstone and Marble

Terracotta

Wood

Painting materials during the Renaissance:

Oil paint is invented.

Perspective with vanishing points used for the first time.
